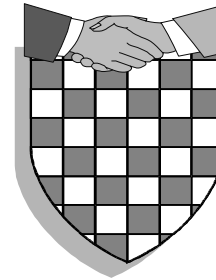

Children's Competition Classes

To commence at 6.15pm and to be judged in the following order

1	Boys	Under 5 years
2	Girls	Under 5 years
3	Boys	5 to 9 years
4	Girls	5 to 9 years
5	Boys	10 to 15 years
6	Girls	10 to 15 years
7	Mixed Pairs	Boy and Girl in complementary dress <i>e.g. Indian (boy) and Squaw (girl)</i> <i>Open to all ages of Boys and Girls under 16 years</i>

Note:- Children may also enter Adult Class 1 as members of their Society's First Pioneer Group only

PRESENTATION of the CHILDREN'S CUPS and MEDALS will be made after the result has been declared for each Class

Adult Competition Classes

To commence at 8pm and to be judged in the following order

1	Pioneer Group		Group to consist of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 persons in the costume of their Society's FIRST PIONEER as published in their current Programme
2	Pioneer Individual	a b	FIRST PIONEER – Ladies FIRST PIONEER – Gentlemen In the costume of their Society's FIRST PIONEER as above whether or not they have entered Class 1
3	Pioneer Pairs		Ladies and Gentlemen In complementary costume of any Society's FIRST PIONEER as above
4	Bonfire Group		Group to consist of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 persons in any complementary costume that is not eligible for Class 1, 2 or 3 – One Group per Society
5	Best Fancy Dress	a b	Ladies Gentlemen Open to any individual costume that has not already appeared in Class 1, 2 or 3
6	Bonfire Pairs		Ladies and Gentlemen In any complementary costume that is not eligible for Class 1, 2 or 3
7	Champion Costume	a b	Ladies Gentlemen Winners of Classes 2, 3, 5 and 6

Followed by Presentation of the ADULT CUPS and TROPHIES

Annual Costume Competition

- The doors will open at 5pm
- Children's Classes will commence at 6.15pm
- Adult Classes will commence at 8pm
- Admission for Spectators and Competitors
Adult - £2.50 / Children under 16yrs - 50p
- The Master of Ceremonies will be Philip Hall Esq.
- The entire building is Non-Smoking
- The adjudicator is Jim Smith, Chairman of Lewes Bonfire Council
- Take-aways are not permitted within the Town Hall complex

Rules of the Competition

1	No means of identification to the competitor's society by badge or whatever to be worn or displayed by the competitor during the competition
2	All competitors must be paid up members of a Lewes Bonfire Society affiliated to the Lewes Bonfire Council and must march with that society on Bonfire Night, or in the case of Nevill Juvenile Bonfire Society, with them on the night of their celebrations
3	An individual may represent only one society during the evening
4	Only one group per society may enter Adult Classes 1 and 4
5	All costumes must be capable of being worn in a torchlight procession
6	Individuals may enter more than one class as long as the costume being worn is eligible for the appropriate class
7	Costumes may not be hired or commercially manufactured
8	No accompanying music is permitted
9	Cups, Trophies and Medals will be presented on the night. Adult Cups and Trophies may be returned after presentation so they may be engraved. These will be returned in due course.
10	Societies eligible to enter are:- Cliffe Bonfire Society, Commercial Square Bonfire Society, Lewes Borough Bonfire Society, Nevill Juvenile Bonfire Society, South Street Bonfire Society, Southover Bonfire Society and Waterloo Bonfire Society
